Chirag meets After loyalty 'warning' from Shah, NDA seat formula almost final

LIZ MATHEW NEW DELHI, OCTOBER 1

A MEETING between top BIF leaders, including Home Minister Amit Shah, and LJP president Chirag Paswan on Thursday hinted that the NDA's seat-sharing formula for the upcoming Bihar election is close to being finalised, BJP sources said.

Party sources said the BJP's Central Election Committee is likely to meet Sunday and release the first list of candidates.

Chirag, who has been under pressure from his party leaders to go it alone in 143 constituencies, met BJP President J P Nadda for the second time this week. "Chirag's meeting with Shah indicates that the LJP would be a part of the NDA in the October -November election," a BJP leader said

While the BJP and JD(U) are continuing their discussions in Patna over the seat-sharing formula, party sources said both sides could agree to keep aside the share of smaller allies from their quota – the BJP would have to provide the LJP seats from its share and the JD(U) would keep aside seats for HAM(S).

This would make the JD(U)'s position more advantageous as the LJP is demanding 25-30 seats while the HAM's requirement is less. "Keeping this in view, the BJP would like to have the bigger chunk in its seat-sharing with the ID(U)," said a BIP leader.

The three-phase elections to the 243-member Assembly will begin on October 28. Results will be declared on November 10.







WITH A senior official from the US, apart from the UK, the European Union (EU) and the United States Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF), raising the issue o Amnesty India shutting down its operations, New Delhi on Thursday said that it expects other governments to "not condone contravention of Indian laws by any entity".

Ministry of External Affairs' official spokesperson Anurag Srivastava on Thursday said that the Union Home Ministry, which deals with FCRA-related issues and foreign funding of NGOs, has said that "NGOs are expected to adhere to all our laws, including in respect of foreign funding, just as they presumably would, in other countries including in the US, and in the European Union".

He said, "We also expect that other governments would not condone contravention of Indian laws by any entity."

Earlier on Thursday, a senior US State Department official told journalists in Washington DC that Amnesty International shutting down its operations in India, after its bank accounts were frozen, "has received attention at the highest levels" in the US government.

Asked about New Delhi's action against Amnesty International, the official said, "We've been focused, we've been very, very closely following this issue... It has received attention at the highest levels of our government. We look forward to a response, and a resolution to a situation that's consistent with international principles and the rule of law.'
